Preamble t.

WHEREAS the Employers and Trade Unions have been engaged in collective bargaining, under the auspices of the National Bargaining Council for the Wood and Paper Sector, to review the terms and conditions of employment in the Sawmilling Chamber,

WHEREAS the Parties have now reached an agreement on wages and conditions of employment.

NOW the parties wish to record this agreement in the following terms:

The Scope of the Agreement 2.

This agreement shall apply to all wage-earning employees of the employers within the Sawmilling Chamber of the Bargaining Council for the Wood and Paper Sector.

The scope can be extended to other job categories where organized tabour can prove majority representation in the Sector.

The Duration of the agreement 3.

This agreement will commence on 1 July 2019 and endure to 30 June 2020.

Wage Increase 4

The Parties agree to an increase of not tess than 6% on the current actual basic wage effective 1 July 2019 to all employees in the Bargaining Unit.

5. Minlmum wage

The Parties agree that the Industry minimum wage will increase by R 235.60 to R 4, 135,00 per month with effect from 1 July 2019.

Shift Allowances

The Parties agree that the shift allowances payable for night work only, will be not less than 12% of basic wage.

7. Maternity/Paternity leave

The Parties agree that the maternity benefits payable to female employees on the birth of a child will be equal to 42% of monthly basic wage payable for a maximum period of four months.

Paternity leave will be in line with the prevailing statutory provisions.

Long Service Award

Parties agreed that the current scenario prevail where various employers deal with this issue in line with their circumstances at company level.

Housing and transport allowance

Parties agreed that the current scenario to prevail where various employers deal with these issues in line with their circumstances at company level.

The parties agree any discussion at company level regarding the above, will only take place within the structures of the Bargaining Council.

10. Job Security

10.1 Temporary Employment Services

Employers will comply with the existing Labour Relations Act provisions, in respect of Temporary Employment Services

10.2 Equal Pay for Work of Equal Value

Employers will comply with the existing Labour Relations Act provisions, in respect of Equal Pay for Work of Equal Value.

11. Other conditions of employment

As other terms and conditions of employment not amended by this agreement shall remain unchanged.

12. Full and Final Settlement

The undersigned Parties agree that the afore-going constitute the final agreement between the parties emanating from the 2019 wage negotiations. This document constitutes the entire agreement between the Parties and no other variation to this agreement shall be binding to the parties unless such variation is reduced to writing and signed by all Parties to this agreement.
